Frieze Week And Alternative Satellite Art Fair Guide 2014











The main fair and collateral offspring launch the week of 12 October, with the main fair opening to the public on the 15th October. Each year our capital is over-run with the international art crowd, who flock to this once a year cultural phenomenon. Frieze and Frieze Masters promises to showcase an up to date overview of the current art market allowing art lovers to pay homage to the best (and some of the worst) in visual art. Rolls-Royce Motor Cars will present a new installation by Turner Prize nominee and renowned artist Angela Bulloch in their showroom on Berkeley Square in London to coincide with Frieze Week 2014. Bulloch, who is a member of the 'Freeze' generation of Young British Artists, will present a new commission, taking the form of a 'Pixel Box' installation that will mimic the properties of a Rolls-Royce car.
